

It's Time to Declare a Climate Emergency


"I want you to act as you would in a crisis. I want you to act as if our house is on fire. Because it is."

On March 5, Kingston city council declared a climate emergency.




### Council committed to:

- How will we get there?




It may not be enough.


There has been no analysis of whether these actions will get Kingston to zero emissions by 2040 or 2050.








71% strongly support and 12% somewhat support climate action to stay within 1.5C.



86% of respondents believe that, at a minimum, that the City should do something about climate change with 52% saying that the City must do something to fight climate change regardless of the cost.

Which of the following best describes your view of what, if any, action the City of Kingston should take regarding climate change.







Figure 15. Willingness of respondents to make financial contribution to climate change action. Number of respondents: 909; number skipped: 267.






# Climate Action Working Group
